Members of the Regensburg Cathedral Choir, known as the *Domspatzen* (The Cathedral "Sparrows"), performed at the German School in Potomac, Maryland, May 2nd. Drawing influences from the Baroque and classical eras, along with modern German folk music, the Regensburg Cathedral boasts an immense repertoire.

Several RSCC members attended. The 62 singers and 4 adults were hosted by German School families; among them was the German School Headmaster Herr Waldemar Gries.

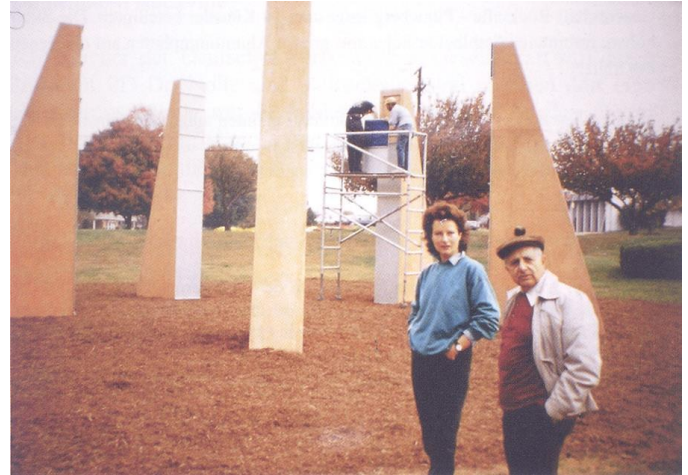
Gift from Pinneberg – Welsh Park Sculpture

Have you ever seen the rather unusual sculpture that sits in Welsh Park on the corner of Mannakee and Martins Lane? It was a gift from the City of Pinneberg, created by the sculptor Gabriele Schmidt-Heins and dedicated in October 1991.

Although artists are loathe to reveal the specifics of their inspiration, over the years certain insights come to light. The following description (believed to be from Ms. Schmidt-Heins' initial proposal for construction of the sculpture), may not be 100% true, but

nonetheless seems like a plausible everyman's guide for interpretation.

The accessible sculpture "On Site" symbolizes a modern "Thingstätte", an open-air meeting place where Germanic tribes met for conducting matters of social, judicial and military importance.



The circular form symbolizes eternity.

The five pillars are colored in an earth tone; - four top plates are blue, a spiritual color -- while the northern pillar's black top plate represents the transitoriness or impermanence of all things.

The inner surfaces are scored in halves, moving to infinitely smaller divisions.

No matter how you view it, our relationship with our friends in Pinneberg remains a real work of art!
